

ASC and FSGP Graphics Notes

Use a vector based PDF or SVG image when possible since this will retain the full image detail at any size. If one of these formats is not supported in your application, select the appropriately sized raster image to balance file size and pixel resolution. Below is a brief overview of the provided file formats and color options. Transparency for non-white backgrounds is supported in all of the formats except JPG.

Vector images: resolution independent files that can be enlarged to any size without degradation

PDF: Commonly used format for documents but not widely supported as an image format

SVG: High quality web format but limited program support

Large, medium, and small raster images: bitmap files that become pixelated when made larger

PNG: High quality format with transparency support

JPG: Commonly used format with slight compression but no transparency support


GIF: Web format with small file sizes and transparency support






ASC Color Logo
