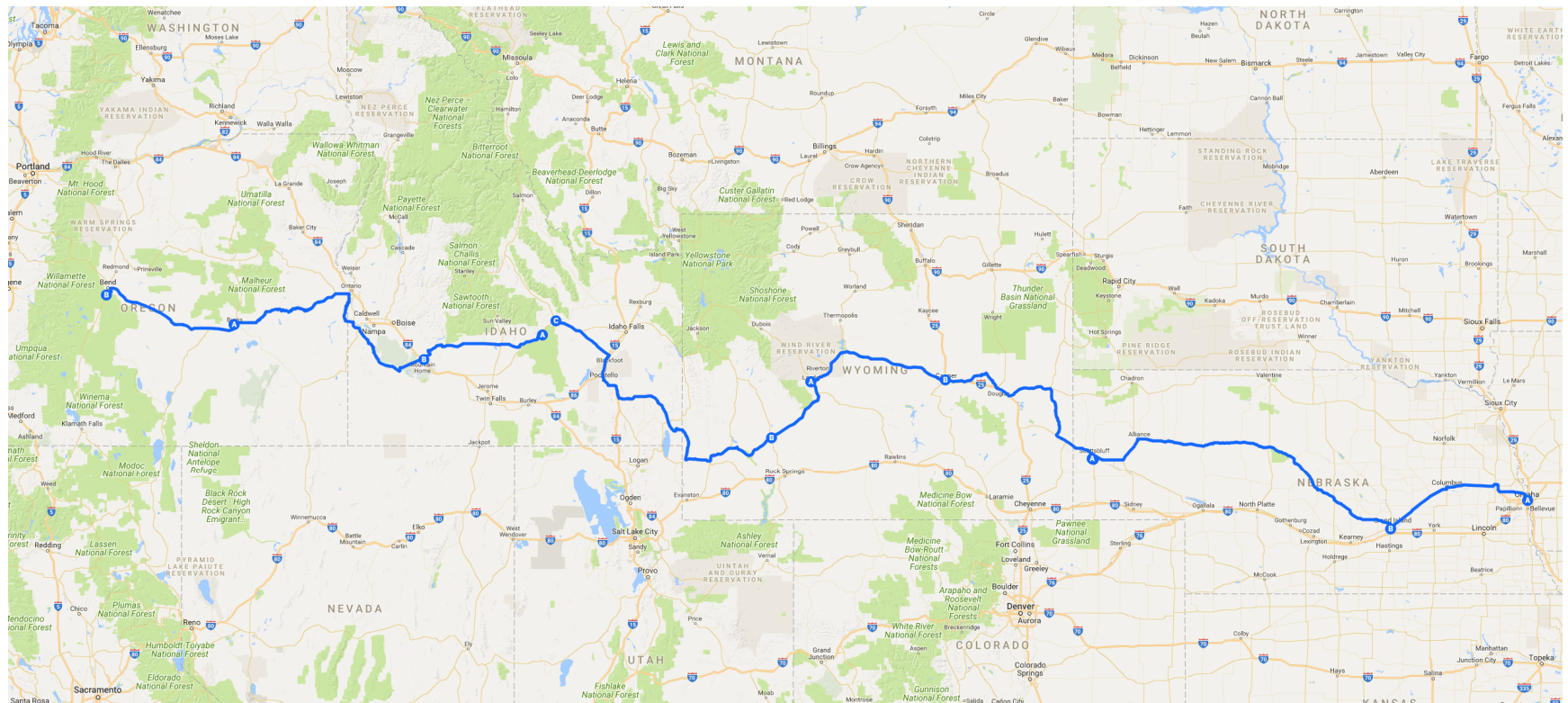

<b>July 18th:</b>	Stage Start in Lander, WY Checkpoint in Farson, WY
<b>July 19th:</b>	Stage Stop in Arco, ID
<b>July 20th:</b>	Stage Start at Craters of the Moon NM, ID Checkpoint in Mountain Home, ID
<b>July 21st:</b>	Stage Stop in Burns, OR
<b>July 22nd:</b>	Stage Start in Burns, OR Finish in Bend, OR





This Route Book contains the ASC 2018 route steps, which define the official course from Omaha, NE to Bend, OR. Should changes to the route become necessary (due to construction or otherwise), please follow the updated route steps as given by the stage/checkpoint crews.

The Major Turns/Instructions column lists all directions necessary for following the route. Mileages given in the Trip and Int (interval) columns are not precise to the hundredth of a mile. A distance of 0.25 should be interpreted as "between 0.2 and 0.3 miles".

Other data is provided for additional reference. Please note that not all traffic lights, changes in lanes, speed limit or shoulder condition, or available services are listed. In completing the course, all traffic laws must be obeyed at all times.

When you reach the end of a segment, watch for a flag person to direct you into the checkpoint/stage stop. Proceed under the direction of the checkpoint/stage point crew.

## KEY FOR ASC 2018 ROUTE BOOK

### Description of Route Book Columns

<b>Step</b>	Alphabetical lettering of segments and numerical ordering of steps; allows easy reference for communicating location along route Note: please use step letter/number when informing staff of your location.
<b>Trip</b>	The cumulative number of miles completed within each section
<b>Int (Interval)</b>	The number of miles from the previous step to the current step
<b>Major Turns/Instructions</b>	All turns and key instructions for following the route
<b>Landmarks/Notes</b>	Key landmarks to mark your location on the route and other helpful guidance for completing the course
<b>Ln (Lane)</b>	Number of driving lanes going your direction
<b>Spd (Speed)</b>	Speed limit (mph) Note: all changes in speed limits are NOT recorded. Regardless of if a speed limit is recorded in the route book, all posted speed limits must be followed. Where the posted speed limit is over 65 mph, the ASC maximum speed limit is still 65 mph.
<b>Shoulder</b>	General assessment of shoulder conditions
<b>Services</b>	Known services available at time of last route drive
